CONDITIONS FOR ENROLLMENT
AS SHOWN ON THE ENROLLMENT FORM

1. The camper and his or her parents and relatives agree to abide by the rules and regulations set by the camp for the health, safety, and welfare of the campers. All camper forms are due June 1st, 2011, regardless of the session in which the camper is enrolled. If enrolling after June 1st, all forms are due two-weeks prior to the session your camper is enrolled.
2. **Due to the fact that all camping programs are planned prior to the opening of camp, including purchasing camper supplies, equipment, and hiring of personnel, based on confirmed camper reservations, no allowance, refunds, or rebates can or will be made if cancellation occurs after May 15th**
3. The camp reserves the right to dismiss a camper whose conduct or influence is unsatisfactory, or is, in the opinion of the Camp Director, not in the best interest of the camp. In that event, there shall be no refund in any amount of the camp tuition and the parent is responsible for any additional costs incurred to transport the camper(s) home.
4. The camp is not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings lost or damaged by fire, theft, laundry, misplacement, etc.
5. Should both parents leave their place of residence for an extended period of time during the camp session, the Camp Director must be notified where they can be contacted in case of an emergency.
6. In case of medical or surgical emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the Camp Director to hospitalize and secure proper treatment for the camper listed. All such expenses will be the responsibility of, and shall be paid for by, the parents.
7. A health examination form, filled out by a physician, must be submitted no later than June 1st, 2011. **NO CAMPER WILL BE ACCEPTED TO CAMP WITHOUT A HEALTH EXAMINATION FORM.**
8. The undersigned consents to the use of any pictures of this child for the purpose of advertising and promotion of River Way Ranch Camp.

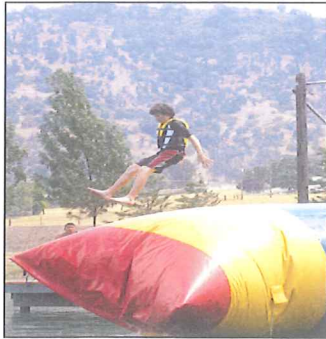

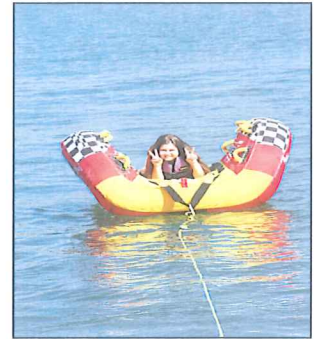

Last year, our Senior campers in Session I, II, III & IV, experienced the trip of a lifetime - whitewater river rafting down the Kings River! With record snowfall this past winter, the river should be flowing through Session IV again this summer.

This form is an authorization to allow your camper to participate in the whitewater rafting trip, if it is available to River Way Ranch Camp. We DO NOT guarantee this trip as it is dependent on the water level, which is driven by the snow pack. However, we do anticipate providing this activity in part for 2011, and hope that it will be available for all four sessions.

Visitor's Acknowledgement of Risk**

I (we) recognize the element of risk in any adventure sport or activity associated with the outdoors. I (we) am (are) fully aware of the risks and dangers inherent in whitewater river running or travel upon mountain roadways such as, but not inclusive of: vehicle or raft upset or collision, exposure to inclement weather, immersion in water, ejection from our falling while on board a raft, collision with rocks, persons, equipment or other objects. Falling while on shore and/or entering or alighting from vehicles or rafts, bites or spray by insects, animals or reptiles, exposure to poisonous plants and damage to or loss of personal property.

I specifically understand that Kings River Expeditions provides foot cups in its boats to assist participants in stabilizing themselves. I understand the choice of using the foot cups is entirely up to me. Kings River Expeditions has found that participants run a greater risk of falling out of boats and suffering serious injury and/or death in the water if they elect not to use the foot cups. However, I also understand that in certain situations use of foot cups can present an increased risk of knee, ankle, or other injuries because of the restrictive nature of the foot cup. Thus I understand that there are risks of serious injury/death in rafting where or not foot cups are used.

Knowing the risks and danger, I (we) understand the possible consequences of participating in such activity(s) include but are not limited to discomfort, injury, or loss of life.

I (we) certify that I (we) have the necessary skills and ability to participate in the said activity(s) and assume full responsibility for myself (ourselves) for bodily injury, health and loss of personal property and expenses thereof as a result of my (our) negligence in participating in said activity(s) except to the extent such damage or injury may be used for promotional and/or commercial purposes.
